1. What stood out to you the most from this message? Were there any concepts that were new to you?
2. How have you been taught to see what you have? Would you consider yourself a generous person? Why or why not?
3. As a follower of Christ, why is it problematic to believe the gifts of the Creator are possessions of the creature? How does seeing what you have as a gift and you as a steward change things?
4. Do you wrestle with the belief that the world and others owe you? How can choosing an attitude of gratitude free you from the resentment and anger that comes with that belief?

# First Sunday of Ordinary Time “Owned” Pastor Kris Beckert

## How do you see what you have?

### I. The Christian faith gives some practical truths about how to treat what we have.

### II. The Parable told by Jesus:

*Luke 20:9-16 He went on to tell the people this parable: “A man planted a vineyard, rented it to some farmers and went away for a long time. <sup>10</sup> At harvest time he sent a servant to the tenants so they would give him some of the fruit of the vineyard. But the tenants beat him and sent him away empty-handed. <sup>11</sup> He sent another servant, but that one also they beat and treated shamefully and sent away empty-handed. <sup>12</sup> He sent still a third, and they wounded him and threw him out. <sup>13</sup> “Then the owner of the vineyard said, ‘What shall I do? I will send my son, whom I love; perhaps they will respect him.’ <sup>14</sup> “But when the tenants saw him, they talked the matter over. ‘This is the heir,’ they said. ‘Let’s kill him, and the inheritance will be ours.’ <sup>15</sup> So they threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. “What then will the owner of the vineyard do to them? <sup>16</sup> He will come and kill those tenants and give the vineyard to others.”*
