 - "restored" = charizomai, which includes Greek root charis, meaning _____
5. _____ in the work of God (v.23-25)
 - Epaphras= founder of church in Colossae (Col 1:7)
 - Mark= had gone with Barnabas after a conflict with Paul (Acts 15:36-41), but now is back
 - Luke= physician with Paul on his third missionary journey (Col 4:14)
 - Demas= companion to Paul who later deserts him (2 Tim 4:10)
